PHASE III . . . COMPUTER ASSISTED PRESENTATION RULES

PURPOSE: The speaker will demonstrate the ability to organize, access, and deliver an integrated presentation using technology in a fluid manner by writing and delivering an informative and/or persuasive speech that is enhanced and supported by computerized video and /or audio aids.

- This presentation is to be scripted word for word by the speaker.
- The presentation must include a minimum of five sources excluding graphics.
- The final slide(s) will include all works cited including graphics.
- The speaker must use a computer/computerized device during the presentation.
- Props and costumes are not allowed.
- Electrical access is not guaranteed. Screen projection is not allowed. Speaker should bring computer fully charged and be ready to present when called upon.
- Script submission form must be signed by the Chapter Sponsor or their representative.
- Presentation will be electronically submitted at each ICCFS tournament.

TIME ALLOTTED: 6 minutes includes set-up & breakdown
Time begins when the speaker takes the platform with their computer/computerized device and ends when the speaker leaves the platform with their computer/computerized device.

ETHICS: All speakers are expected to demonstrate academic integrity and adhere to the highest ethical standards for commanding the platform. See *ICC Standards and Practices* for additional information.
