PHASE III . . . THEMATIC RELIGIOUS READING RULES

(For the 2011 Spring Tournaments, YSG Phase II Students may participate in Phase III events)

PURPOSE: The speaker will weave together scripture with their choice of literature to write a speech on a theme of their choosing, delivering it with the use of a binder/notebook.

- The speech is to be scripted word for word by the speaker.
- Speeches will develop a theme using scripture.
- In addition to scripture, the speaker will incorporate original writing and up to a maximum of three literary sources.
- Literary selection(s) must be taken from a physical copy of the primary source.
- The speaker will deliver the speech using a binder/notebook which contains the script.
- Props, costumes, and audiovisuals are not allowed.
- Scripts must be signed by the Chapter Sponsor or their representative and submitted at all ICCFS tournaments.

TIME ALLOTTED: 6 minutes

ETHICS: All speakers are expected to demonstrate academic integrity and adhere to the highest ethical standards for commanding the platform. See *ICC Standards and Practices* for additional information.
